



SPORT SKILL AND ACTIVITY INSTRUCTORS

(Team, Dual and Individual Sports, Dance, Cheerleading, Pilates, Yoga, Wellness)

Sport Skill and Activity Instructors are responsible for teaching scheduled classes, and clinics. This will include but is not limited to:

- Teaching participants the necessary skills to successfully participate in the sport or recreational activity being taught.
- Employing developmentally appropriate activities and instructional strategies.
- Providing regular feedback and assessments to participant and parents.
- Expanding program offerings in consultation with Dr. John's Sports Center.
- Developing collaborative relationships with community organizations.

This position requires a person with the ability, desire and enthusiasm to work with children ages 5 – 18 and build community participation among parents, children and diverse community groups. Activity Instructors must have experience as an instructor or coach, skilled in the activity to be taught and demonstrate effective interpersonal and communication skills.

Applicants must meet Texas legal qualifications for working in a child care facility, pass a criminal history and possess Community CPR and First Aid certifications. The employer may subsidize employee cost of obtaining these certifications.

Dr. John's Sports Center is currently under construction with an anticipated late January 2006 opening date. Employment may begin as early as opening depending on scheduling of classes.

This is a part-time time position. Salary is competitive and commensurate with experience and qualifications. Range is \$15 to \$17 per teaching hour.

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
